The location and dates provide the most options for a flexible cruising weekend. Boston Harbor is close enough to allow some the option of an overnight cruise and allow others to sail to Constitution Marina and access to the North End for the second night.

Spectacle Island has an excellent marina available for overnight tie-ups. The plan is to have a pot luck dinner on the island Saturday night.
